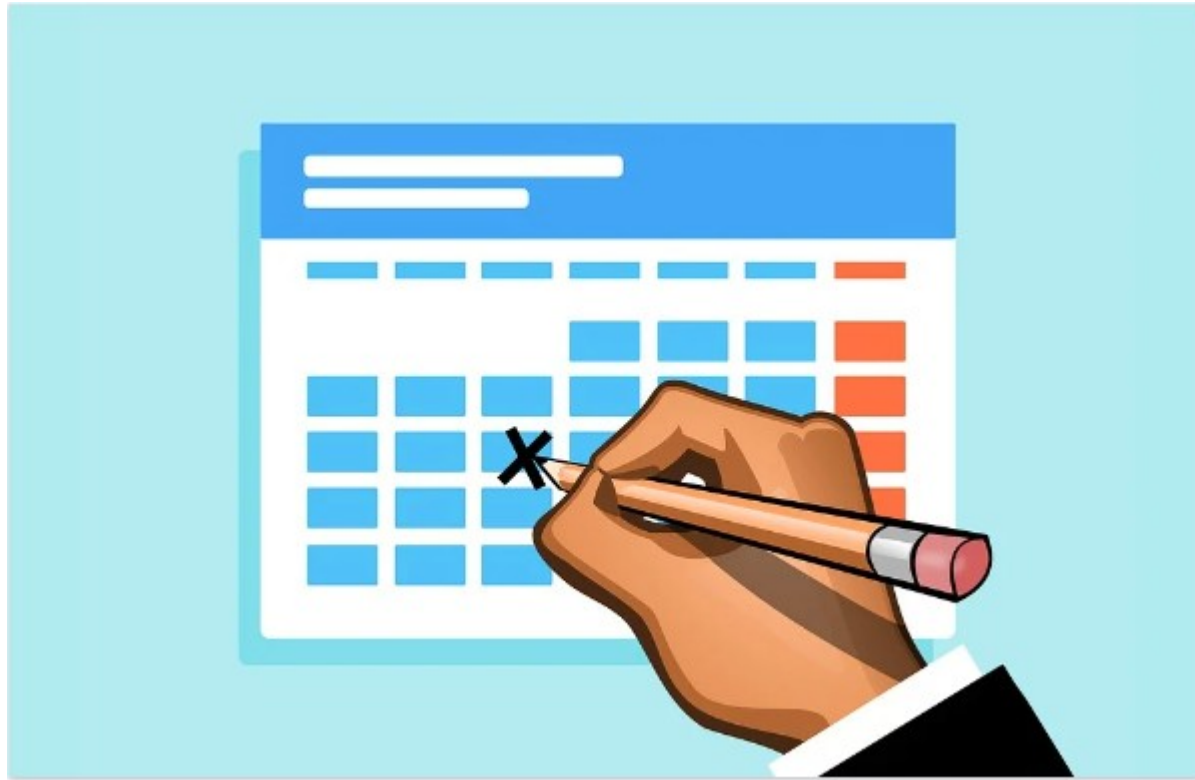

# Discussion

- Ratsupport.com's Database Applications can have a calendar and this presentation is here to help you use it.
- I am using the Calendar for my Class of 63 Database but, the principles are the same for any Calendar.
- The way it works is there are tables that are linked to the Calendar and by putting data into a record it will show up in the Calendar.

# The Calendar

This is what it looks like, the colors have meaning.

In this calendar the light blue are for holidays, the light green are for Mailings and there is a yellow or cream for Events.

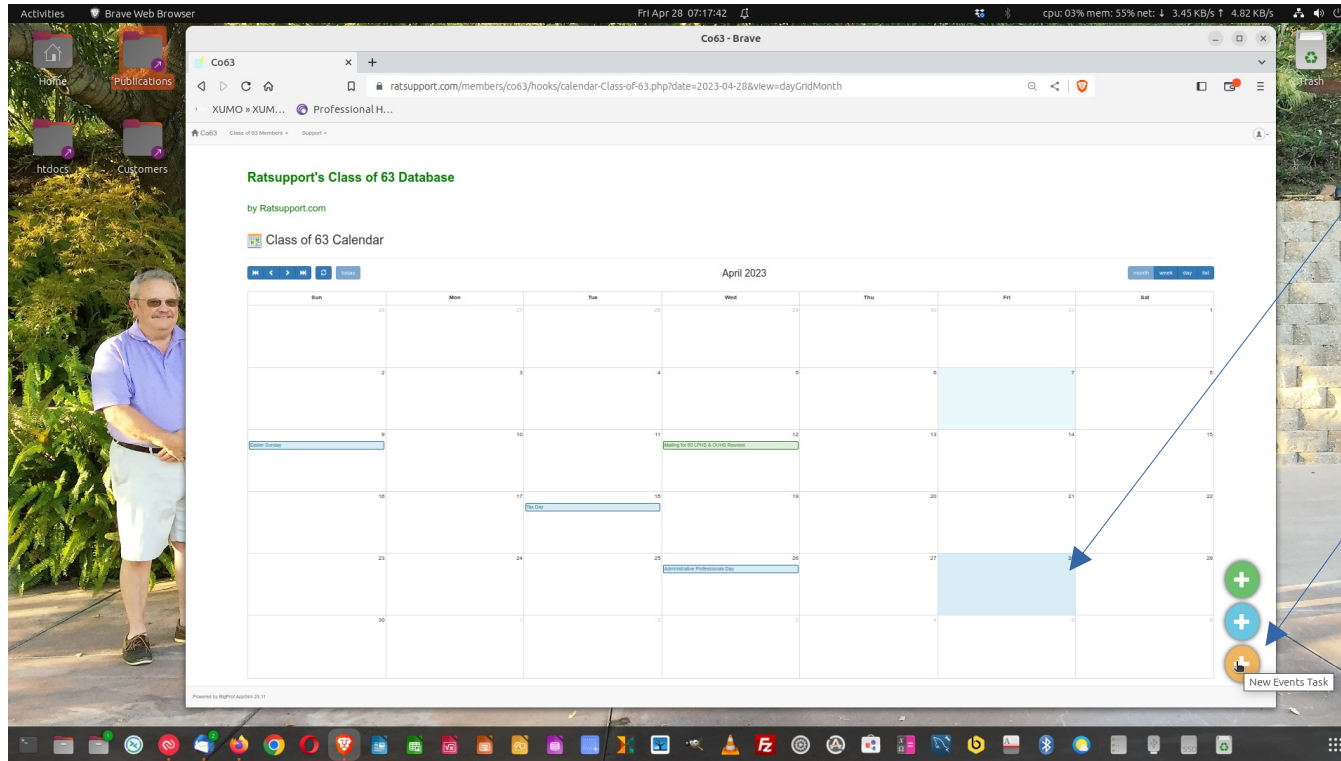
This varies with the calendar but you can click on the color and see the complete record.

Navigation is done in the upper left with the direction arrows,

You can leave the calendar by clicking on the house icon upper left.

If you have permission to make additions to the calendar you can just left click on the date and colored +’s will appear and you can select the table to make the entry into.

As you can see the yellow is for Events and by clicking on this + you will get the table to make your entry.

In this application the Green is for mailings, the blue is for holidays and the yellow is for events.

Your application may be different in use but the use is the same.

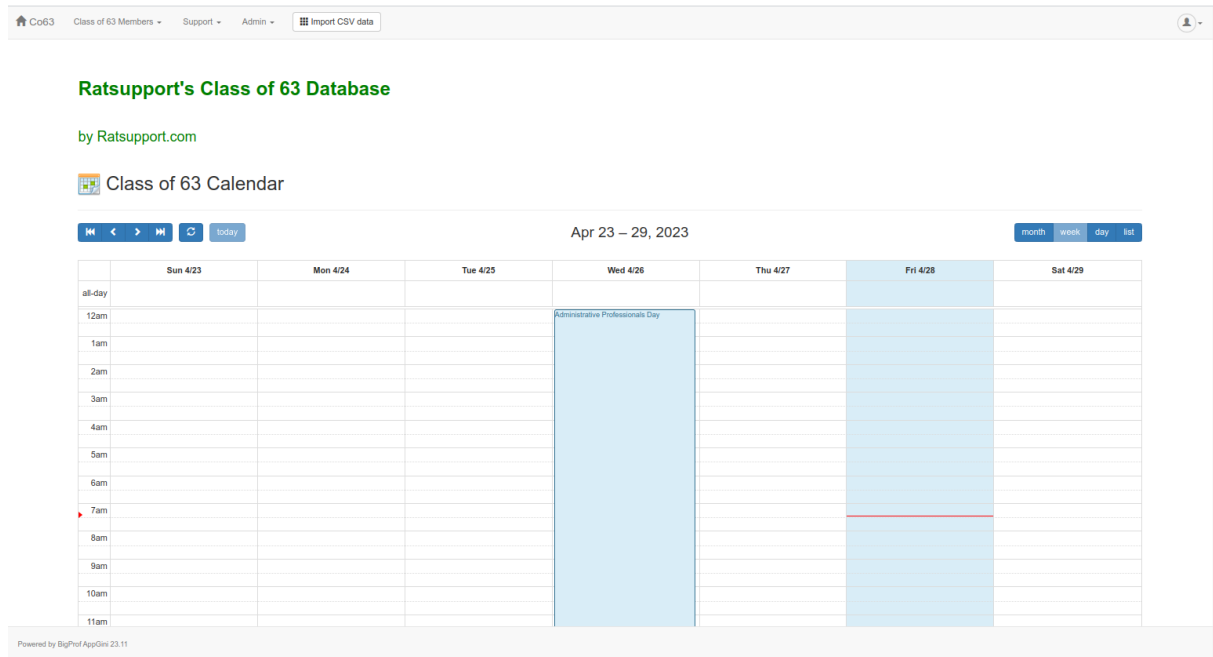

This is Month.



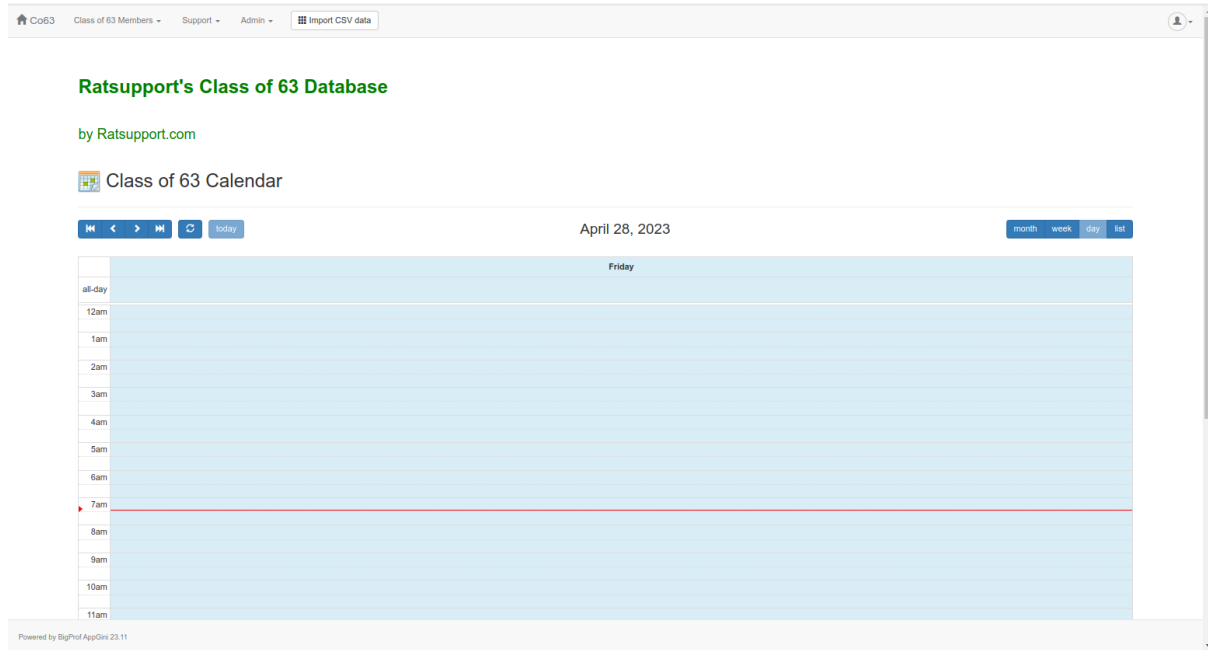
# By the Week



By the week shows each day and the time allocated to each event.

It shows the data by the hour.

# By the Day



By the Day shows the time allocations and the red line is the current time.

If you are using this calendar for a Schedule you would be able to see the various times .

# By the List

As you can see the list shows data over a range of time.
