
Discussion

- The Humor Database Application was created using MySQL, Appgini app and various programming applications to be used with a Web Server.
- By using this type application more than one person can have access to this application and make changes at the same time
 without additional programming or loading of applications to computers. These applications us the browsers of the users
 device.
- The purpose for this Database is to allow users share and have fun.
- This Presentation only shows information that is for this application, login, register and usage is in another publication found on the Ratsupport.com website.
- Please realize that this is the basic configuration of this application and it is very configurable.
- This Database Application is made of up Tables with Records that have a number of fields in them. These Tables are separated by Tabs (Blue) that allow for according effect to separate Tables into logical groupings.
- To view the data in a Table the user needs to click on the Table Button and view the Table View of the data. For Data Entry the user will select a record or push the Add New Button (green).

What to Look For

- The person's head in a circle (upper right) is the user's menu and has things like messages, profile information and allows for changing of the user's password.
- Most tables have a + and a circle with a number inside. This allows the user to add data to the table and shows the number of records in that table.
- There are common things throughout this Database Application and you might want to check them out.
- The Quick Search on the Main Page is for searching Tables and not records. If the user opens a Table
 in Table View they will see a Quick Search for searching records.
- This database applications has some tables that are similar so I will not be showing all in this Presentation.
- There are different permissions for different users that can be setup by the Manager or Administrator of the Application. This means that not all Tabs or Tables may not be visible to all users.


Main Landing Page (SignIn)



This page allows for the user to Sign In to the database application if they are registered or allows the user to Sign Up and register. Sign Up will require some administrator action so the user must wait until notified by email.

This database has some guest privileges to see the data in the main tables. If you are on this page and want to just be a guest then click on the link *continue browsing* as a guest.

Main Landing Page (Guest)




This is the Main Landing Page (Home Page) of the Humor DB Application.

By clicking on one of the tables you can see the table view of that table, Cartoons, Jokes and Riddles.

The user can also navigate to the main server pages.

The user can always get back to this page by clicking on the Application Name (Home)

Support Tab (Tables)



By clicking on the Support Tab you will see the Support Tables.

Normally the user does not have to access these tables as the data in them can be entered from the Detail View of one of the Main Tables.

Cartoons Table View





Table Views show the records in the table.

The user can select the Detail View by clicking on one of the links in a record (not email or website).

If you are registered then you will see the Add New button along with a few more to the right.

There is also a Quick Search field that the user can enter data they want to find.


Cartoon Filter



Filters are used to allow the user to filter unwanted data in the Table. This slide shows the filter created by the plugin *Search Page Maker*.

If this is not implemented or the user wants to do a more complex filter then they can click on the *Switch to Advanced Search Mode*.

Cartoons Detail View




The Detail View of a table is where the user will do their data entry and saving of the record.

This view has two columns and depending on a few variables you can have 1,2,3 columns, just click on the desired column icon.


Please note the eye and + buttons. The eye button opens the field to allow for editing and the + is for entering new data into the table.

Riddles Detail View



Please note that the Riddles Detail View is a bit different than the Cartoons Detail View. Riddles has a linked table by the name of *Answers* and is at the bottom of the page.


Answers Detail View



This is where the user would enter the answer to the Riddle they entered in the Riddles Table. Please note that you need to select the proper Riddle before entering the answer as they are linked.

Users Menu




The user gets his menu by clicking on the circle with a head in it.

Please not also that this user has a message waiting to be opened.

By clicking on the users name they can get to their profile.

User Profile




The users profile gives the user a chance to change their profile information, change their password and see the table permissions they have.

They can also see their IP address and the Group that they are in.

Plugins

- The Humor DB and other Ratsupport.com Database
 Applications are created by using the Appgini app. Appgini also has a number of Plugins to make a few things a bit better and allow for ease of use.
- Some of the plugins are: Calendar, Mass Update, Messages, Search Page Maker and Summary Reports.
- These Plugins can be added to any application with extra configuration.

Messages



The Message Plugin allows users to communicate with each other. When a user creates a message by clicking on the compose button and sending they do two things. 1. send an email to the selected user and sends them an email telling them they have a message. This view shows the landing page of


the message system.

Messages




By selecting one of the messages the user will see a garbage can that allows them to delete their message. There is also a check all box.

Messages




By clicking on the message the user can Reply or Forward the message. Please note messages that have not been read are in bold type.
