- It is best to have the application open so you can follow this presentation and see the actual pages as you progress through these slides.
- The more recipes in the database the easier it is to do data entry. This is because of the structure of the tables.
- The ingredient, unit fields are unique and have a small red asterisk next to the field label. This allows for the users to select already entered data.

- The Basic use of Ratsupport DB applications presentation covers most of the operational items for all similar database applications.



- Images and Files are limited to 500kb. The contributor is responsible for this limit. The Files download is limited to compressed files so the contributor will have to compress their file (Zip etc).
- The allowable compression formats are zip, rar, gz, tar, iso.
- The allowable Image formats are jpg, jpeg, gif, png, webp.

Tricks & Tips

- As there are some Lookup Fields that will have many data points it will be necessary for the contributor to to learn to just put the first letter or two of a choice and the field choices will go to that data item.
- When entering new data please try to follow the format of others. Using upper / lower case do not sort the same.

Tricks & Tips




The small blue circles by field names is an icon to allow the user to view descriptions and information on that field.

The contributor can change the number of columns the data is displayed format. One, Two and Three columns are available if you have the browser in a resolution and size to allow it.

The contributor selects this using the column icons.

Sign In / Sign Up Page




The user can use the sign in or sign up is not a member to get access to this recipe database.

Application Home Page




This image includes the items available to Administrator and Contributors.

The Admin Tab and the Admin (red) button will not be visible for contributor users.



The contributor has access to three selection tabs. The Recipe Table View (Orange) or one of the navigation selections.


Recipe Table View



To select a record the contributor can click on one of the record links. Please use on that does not contain a internet link.

By clicking on a link the Detail View for this record will be displayed.


Recipe Detail View



This View is where the contributor does their data entry, editing and deleting.

Please note the Ingredients list toward the bottom of the page.


Contributor Detail View



Please note the recipes that were created by this contributor shows up at the bottom of the page.

There is also a Recipe button that will open the table view for this contributor showing the recipes.

Ingredients Table View




Please note that the notes on each record does not display in table view.

There are multiple pages of the ingredients so you can use quick search to find what you are looking for.

You can also use the filter to show selected records.


Ingredients Detail View



If an ingredient is already in the table it will show up here. To edit the information in a field the contributor needs to click on the eye icon. To enter a new item into the table they need to click on the + icon.

Be sure you click on the Save or Save Changes button (Green).

Ingredient Filter View



By filling in the desired info into the fields of the filter will allow the contributor to select desired records.

After putting in your selection data just click the Apply Filters button (Green).
